**2) Complete the presentation of the band “the Beatles” : put the verb into the simple past.**

The Beatles \_\_\_ **were** \_\_\_\_\_ (**be**) an English rock band. They \_\_\_ **formed** \_\_\_\_\_ (**form**) in Liverpool, England in 1960. They \_\_\_ **were** \_\_\_\_\_ (**be**) four members : John Lenon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr.

The Beatles \_\_\_ **used** \_\_\_\_\_ (**use**) parts of many music genre through their career, including classical, rock and pop music. They all \_\_\_ **sang** \_\_\_\_\_ (**sing**) and \_\_\_ **played** \_\_\_\_\_ (**play**) many instruments such as rhythm guitar, bass, drums, harmonica, piano. They \_\_\_ **performed** \_\_\_\_\_ (**perform**) live in concerts from 1960 to 1966. They quickly \_\_\_ **became** \_\_\_\_\_ (**become**) the most influential rock band of all time.

They \_\_\_ **wrote** \_\_\_\_\_ (**write**) many famous songs such as “Hey Jude”, “Come together”, “Let it be” ... They \_\_\_ **broke up** \_\_\_\_\_ (**break up**) in 1970 because of the pressures of fame and each member becoming more independent both in their personal lives and musically.

### 3) Answer the questions about the Beatles:

a. How many members were there in the band The Beatles ?

> *There were four members in the band The Beatles .*

b. Where was the band from?

*The band was from Liverpool.*

c. What instruments did they play?

*They played guitar, bass, drums, harmonica, piano.*

d. How many years did they perform live concerts?

*They performed live concerts for only 6 years.*

e. Why did the band break up?

*The band broke up because of the pressure of fame and because each member became more independent.*



#### **REMEMBER :**

Pour former une phrase negative au passé, on utilise l'auxiliaire DID à la forme négative **DIDN'T** suivi du verbe à l'infinitif.

ex: I began at 7am. > I didn't begin at 7am.

Lorsque le verbe de la phrase est BE (**was/were**), il suffit d'ajouter **NOT** derrière le verbe ou la contraction **wasn't / weren't**.

ex: I was very sad > I was not very sad ou I wasn't very sad.

### 4) Change these sentences into negatives

ex: *The Beatles wrote the song "imagine".*

> *The Beatles **didn't write** the song "imagine".*

a. The Beatles continued to play together after the 1970s.

*The Beatles didn't continue to play together after the 1970s . (**did not** is also correct)*

b. The Beatles played only rock music.

*The Beatles didn't play only rock music.*

c. The Beatles were a band of 6 members.

*The Beatles weren't a band of 6 members. (**were not** is also correct)*

d. Paul McCartney was born in the USA.

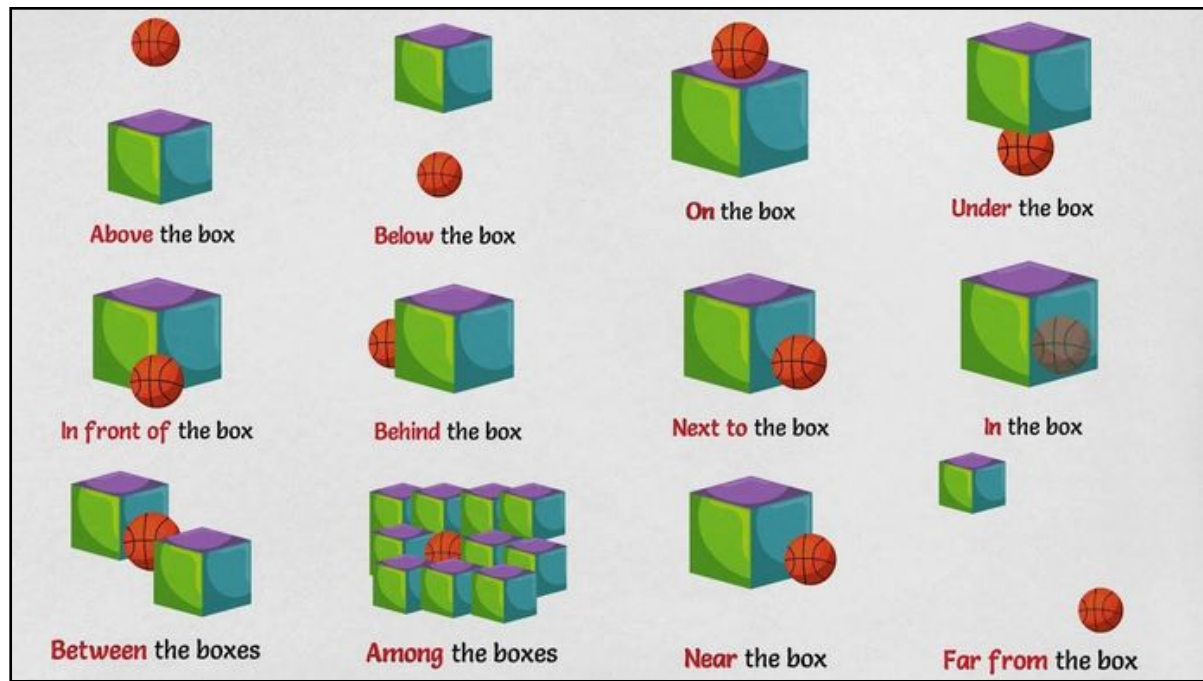
*Paul McCartney wasn't born in the USA. (**was not** is also correct)*

e. They composed only one album.

*They didn't compose only one album. (**did not** is also correct)*

a. Where is the NY Public Library?  
The NY Public Library is **between** the United Nations and Rockefeller Center, **below** St Patrick's Cathedral.

b. Where is Wall Street ?  
Wall street is **next to** the Brooklyn Bridge and **near** ground Zero.

c. Where is the Immigration Museum ?  
The Immigration museum is **on** Elis Island **next to** the Statue of Liberty.

d. Where is Union Square ?  
Union Square is **above** Soho and **below** the Empire State Building .

e. Where is Central Park zoo ?  
Central Park Zoo is **in** Central Park **above** the Museum Modern Art .

ex> This state is on the West Coast, next to Nevada and below Oregon : \_\_\_It is **California**\_\_\_
